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**ZILDJIAN'S NEW "SPIRAL TRASH" BRINGS COUNTLESS SOUND  
OPTIONS TO ANY PERCUSSION SET UP**

*Spiral-cut Cymbal Results In Unique "Coiled" Appearance And Trashy Sound*

**Norwell, MA – February 2007** – The Avedis Zildjian Company, cymbal innovators since 1623, is proud to introduce a unique new cymbal to its FX range of special effect instruments. Available in 16-inch and 18-inch sizes, the Spiral Trash comes in a traditional finish and with a wealth of sonic possibilities.

The Spiral Trash is a Zildjian sheet bronze cymbal that has been cut in a "spiral" pattern starting near the bell and going all the way to the edge. This results in the appearance of a coil when mounted and numerous playing possibilities. The Spiral Trash can be mounted on a regular cymbal stand so its coils wrap down around the stand itself, or hanging from an upside-down cymbal arm so the coils swing free below.

Playable on almost every part of the cymbal, the Spiral Trash has unique overtones and an almost wave-like timbre that can expand the sound of any percussion set up. An extraordinary "trash" sound and unusual shape provides countless options for percussion ensemble, marching band/drum corps, or drum set.

Tested as prototypes at several PAS shows, the Spiral Trashes were put to the test by drum corps Phantom Regiment, The Cadets, Crossmen and Carolina Crown in 2006 and received rave reviews from all. Drum set artists such as Dennis Chambers, Trilok Gurtu and Glen Kotche are also using the new Spiral Trash in their set-ups.
