

# 2017 Percussion Ensemble Entry Form

## 2017 Copyright Information

As part of the agreement in registration, WGI Sport of the Arts requires all enrolled ensembles to acknowledge that they assume responsibility to comply with copyright laws in regards to performance and/or arrangement of copyrighted music, visual images and other materials. Please keep in mind copyright law also covers use of copyrighted audio or spoken text, and the display of copyrighted words and images and use of any dialogue and characterizations from a play, musical or opera.

Percussion ensembles competing at any **WGI Event** must submit to the WGI office proof of approved Permission to Arrange for each song included in their program by the Entry Deadline Date of the ensembles first event. Due to US copyright laws, ensembles failing to do so **WILL NOT** be permitted to compete.

Music selection information should be submitted online prior to the Entry Deadline Date of your first event. You can submit this information by visiting the "Directors Only" area of the WGI website and complete the Song Selection Information for the current season.

All performance video recordings or webcasts of any WGI Regional, Power Regional and/or World Championships performance is authorized for private display only. All other rights reserved unless expressly authorized in writing by WGI. Copying, public display or any other use of the footage or images is strictly prohibited. Public display includes percussion ensembles providing others footage of a WGI event and/or posting the performance online in any form.

Due to the rising cost of copyright compliance administration, any group attending a WGI Event using more than four (4) individual pieces of music in their performance will be invoiced a \$75 licensing fee per song above four (4).
