

COLOR GUARD SPIEL SHEET: Please be sure to complete your color guard's show information under the Dashboard of the Directors Only webpage. If you do not fill out this information prior to the regional then only your guard name, city and state will be announced

ANNOUNCEMENT PROCEDURE: Please familiarize yourself with the announcement procedure located in the 2020 Color Guard Rulebook: Rule 6.7.

GUARD CHECK-IN: Be prepared to declare the number of marching members. Penalties will be assigned for false declarations (Rule 8.2). Marching members and ten (10) staff will be admitted at no charge. Two of these passes will be front side passes. If you purchased a PLUS pass at time of entry, your guard will receive an additional five (5) passes for a total of fifteen (15). PLUS passes are not available for purchase at the event. Color Guards must check-in at least one hour prior to performance time.

DRESSING FACILITIES: These may or may not be available on site. WGI and/or the Event Partners are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

FOOD & DRINK: No outside food or drink is permitted at any WGI event.

FOOTWEAR AND EQUIPMENT PROTECTION: Rule 4.1

TABULATING AND JUDGING AREA: These areas are off limits to everyone except authorized personnel.

SOUND CHECK: One hour prior to the start of the contest and during breaks at the discretion of the Contest Administrator. WGI recommends that every color guard completes a sound check.

EQUIPMENT/PROPS: All equipment and props must be removed from the building immediately following your performance.

VIDEOS: No video cameras will be allowed in any contest venue and no authorized space will be provided for groups to record their performance. Any liability associated with unauthorized recordings will rest with the individual or organization making the recording. WGI does not condone, nor accept any liability for, any unauthorized recording during the event.

QUALIFYING SCORES FOR OPEN & WORLD CLASS GUARDS AT REGIONALS: A minimum score must be reached for all Open and World Class guards to qualify for finals competition at a regional. The following scale only applies to the Open and World Classes. Additional information on the qualifying scores can be found on page 17 of the 2020 Color Guard Rulebook.
