

WGI VIRTUAL ESHOWCASE RULES

1.0 General

1.1 Classes for the eShowcase category are for registration purposes only.

2.0 Timing

- 2.1 No minimum performance time requirements.
- 2.2 Maximum performance time is 8 minutes and a max file length of 10 minutes.

3.0 Performance Area

- 3.1 There are no space restrictions on the performance area.
- 3.2 Performance space can be indoors or outdoors.

4.0 Video Procedure

- 4.1 You will be required to upload your videos for each show separately to FloMarching. Information on how to upload will come at a later date.
- 4.2 All videos must be uploaded by the video upload deadline date or the group will forfeit their entry fees and the entry will be disqualified.
- 4.3 The program must own rights to this video (recorded it yourself) and consent to it being posted on FloMarching for use in this Virtual Event and to WGI for use in any advertising or educational purposes.

5.0 Evaluation

- 5.1 Feedback will be offered by one evaluator via CompetitionSuite.
 - 5.1.1 Color Guard Legacy instructors will be providing the educational feedback for all eShowcase entries.
 - 5.1.2 Percussion Educational feedback will be offered by one evaluator.
 - 5.1.3 Winds Educational feedback will be offered by one evaluator using the Overall Effect criteria.

6.0 Penalties

- 6.1 WGI expects the overall safety of all participants will be the top priority for every production. If it is determined that performers' safety is in question after review of the video, the entry may be disqualified.
- 6.2 Any ensemble violating any rule or part of a rule, or failing to comply in any way for which no specific penalty is provided, shall be penalized for each such violation, up to disqualification at the discretion of the appropriate Division Director or Executive Director.
- 6.3 All programs, soundtracks, thematic and costuming choices must reflect the qualities that would be acceptable for performance at a scholastic venue or suitable for marketing to sponsors on a national level.
- 6.4 Groups using the flag of the United States should follow the <u>U.S. Flag Code</u>. Directors are encouraged to contact the Division Director for guidance prior to performance.

PENALTY: Denial of performance or possible disqualification as determined by the Executive Director in consultation with the appropriate Division Director.
