- The facility is situated on two levels. The color guards enter on the lower level, west entrance. Body will be on the upper level; equipment warm up is on the lower level. Spectators will enter and operate on the upper level.
- School is in session at Xavier University and the Cintas Center is located in the heart of campus. Parking is strictly monitored. Parking for Spectators is free, and spectators may only park in Lot C-2.
- Each color guard will be allotted 4 parking passes for the Bus & Truck Lot. Buses and equipment trucks may park in C-3 or C-4. Buses may pull into the C-1 Lot and unload students and color guard equipment ONLY. Props/floors must be unloaded at the loading dock. See maps for details and traffic flow.
- Unloading/Loading – Groups may not unload until 90 minutes prior to their performance time and must reload immediately following their performance. Props/floors may be unloaded by Lots A-M by the loading dock only.
- Dressing facilities are very limited. Please come in competitive attire.
- A black drape will adorn the back stands of the arena.
- The floor surface is concrete covered with a black tarp. The black strips will be placed approximately 9.5 feet apart from the front to the back of the performance floor. The last strip at the back will vary in width.
- The mixing board for the sound system and the sound person will be located in the front stands. The WGIA sound person will have control of the level of sound. See contest info packet for sound check times.
- The competition area is 106' x 70'. Please see the floor plan for more details.
- There will be electrical power available at the front and back sidelines.
- Height of the facility is more than adequate.
- There are separate areas for body and equipment. Music may be used in both body and equipment warm up at moderate levels.
- There are no floor folding facilities available.
- Traffic can be very congested in Cincinnati and surrounding areas. Xavier University is located northeast of downtown Cincinnati. Please plan accordingly.

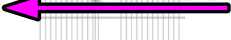

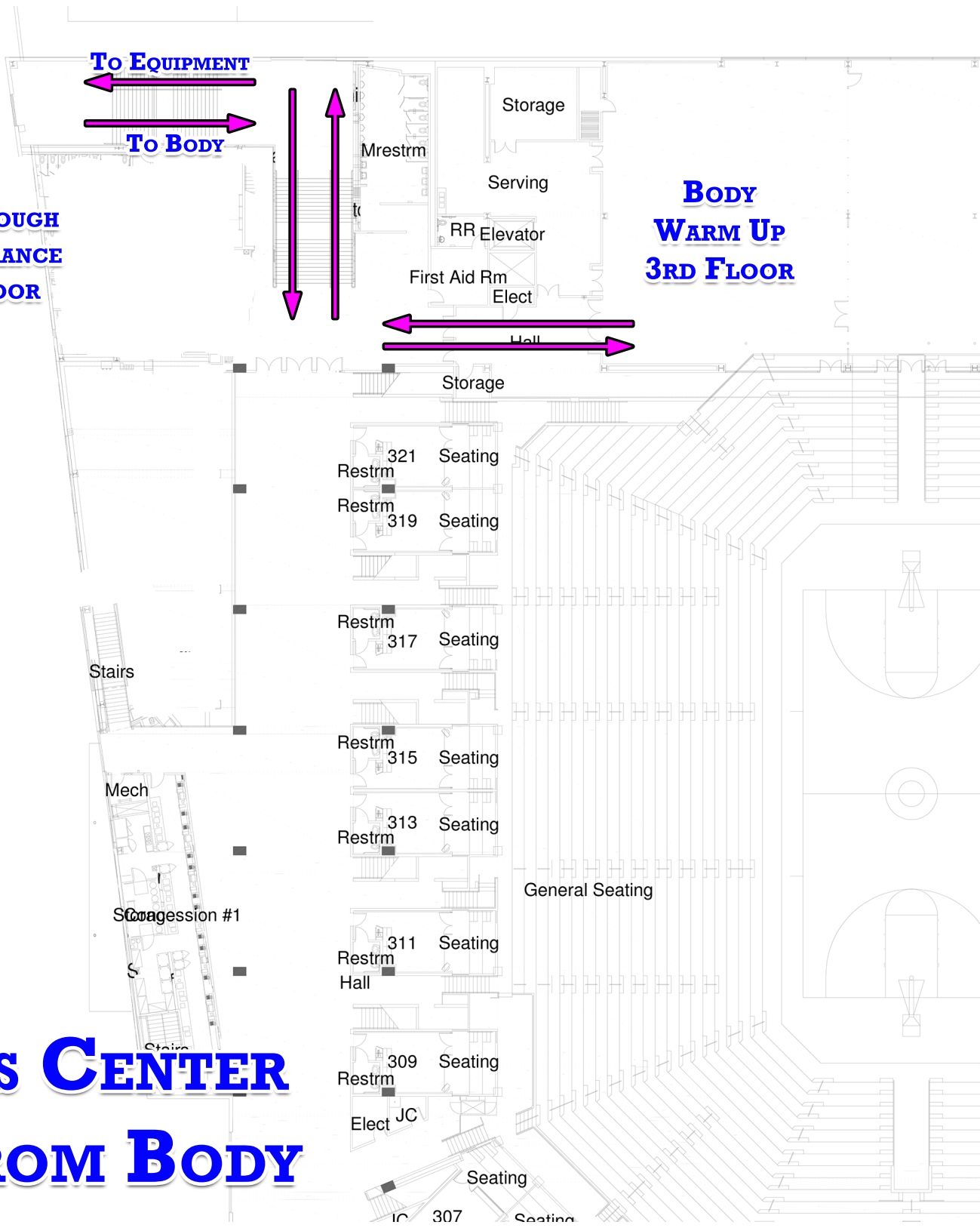

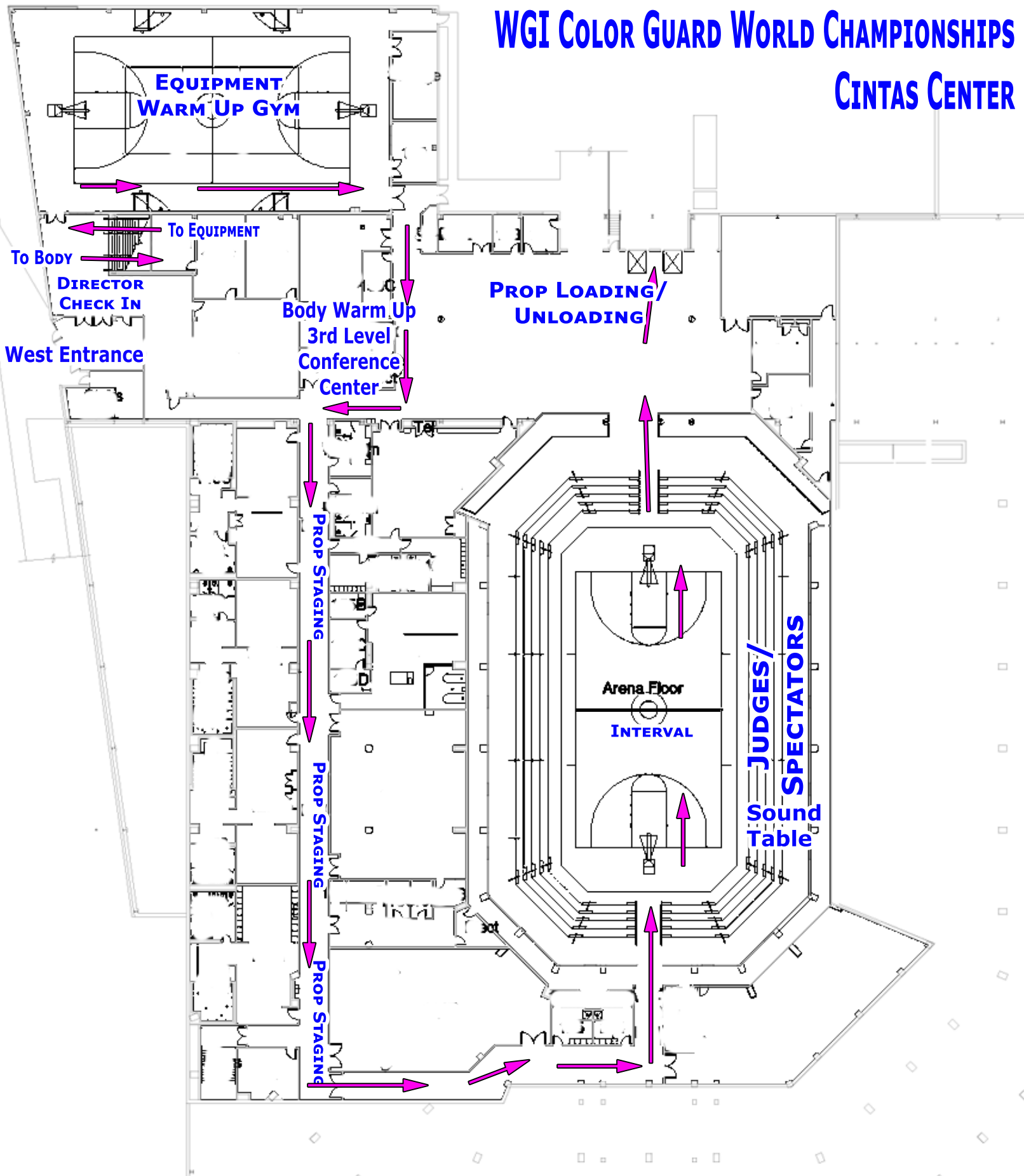

# **CINTAS CENTER To/From BODY**

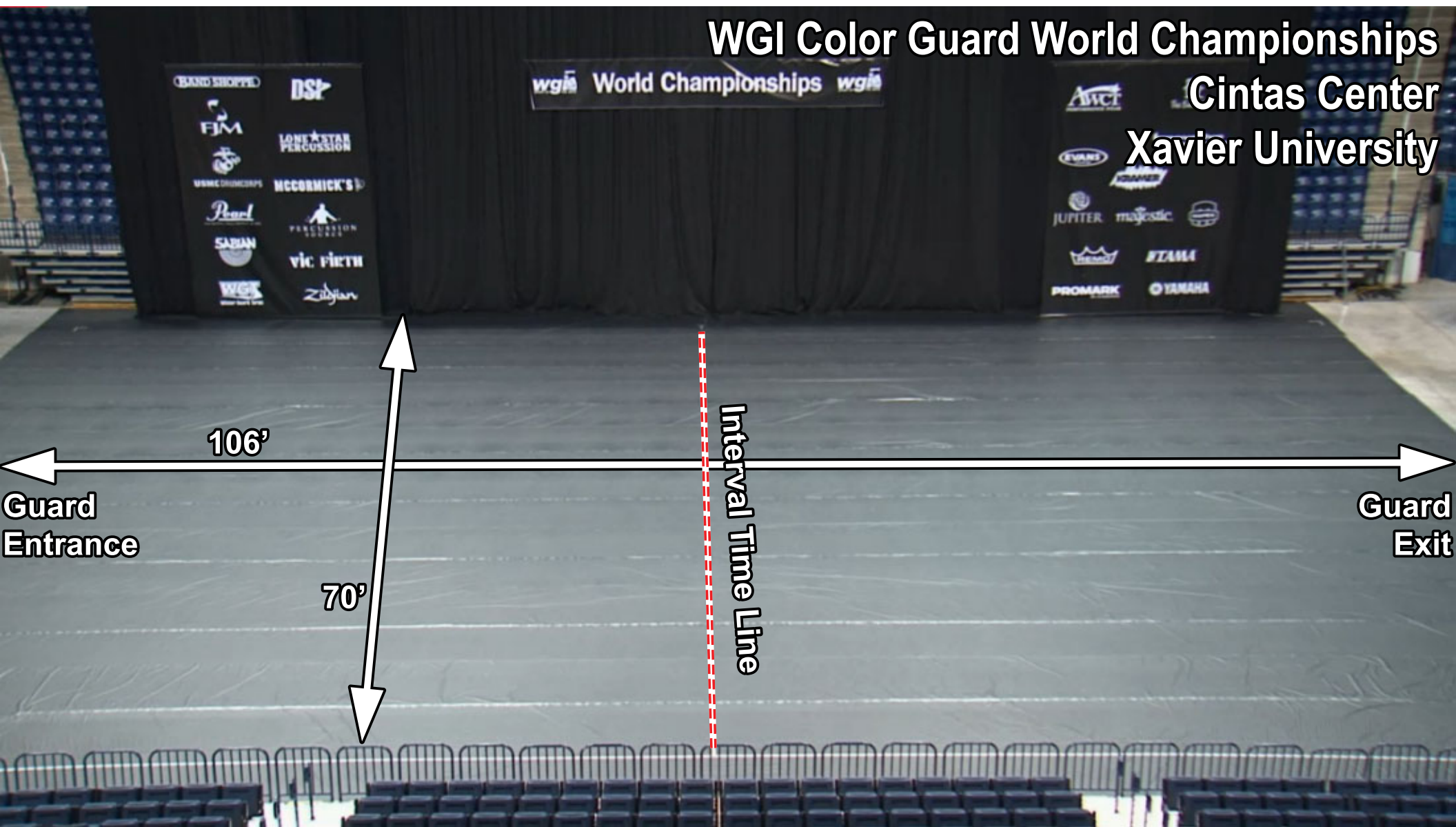

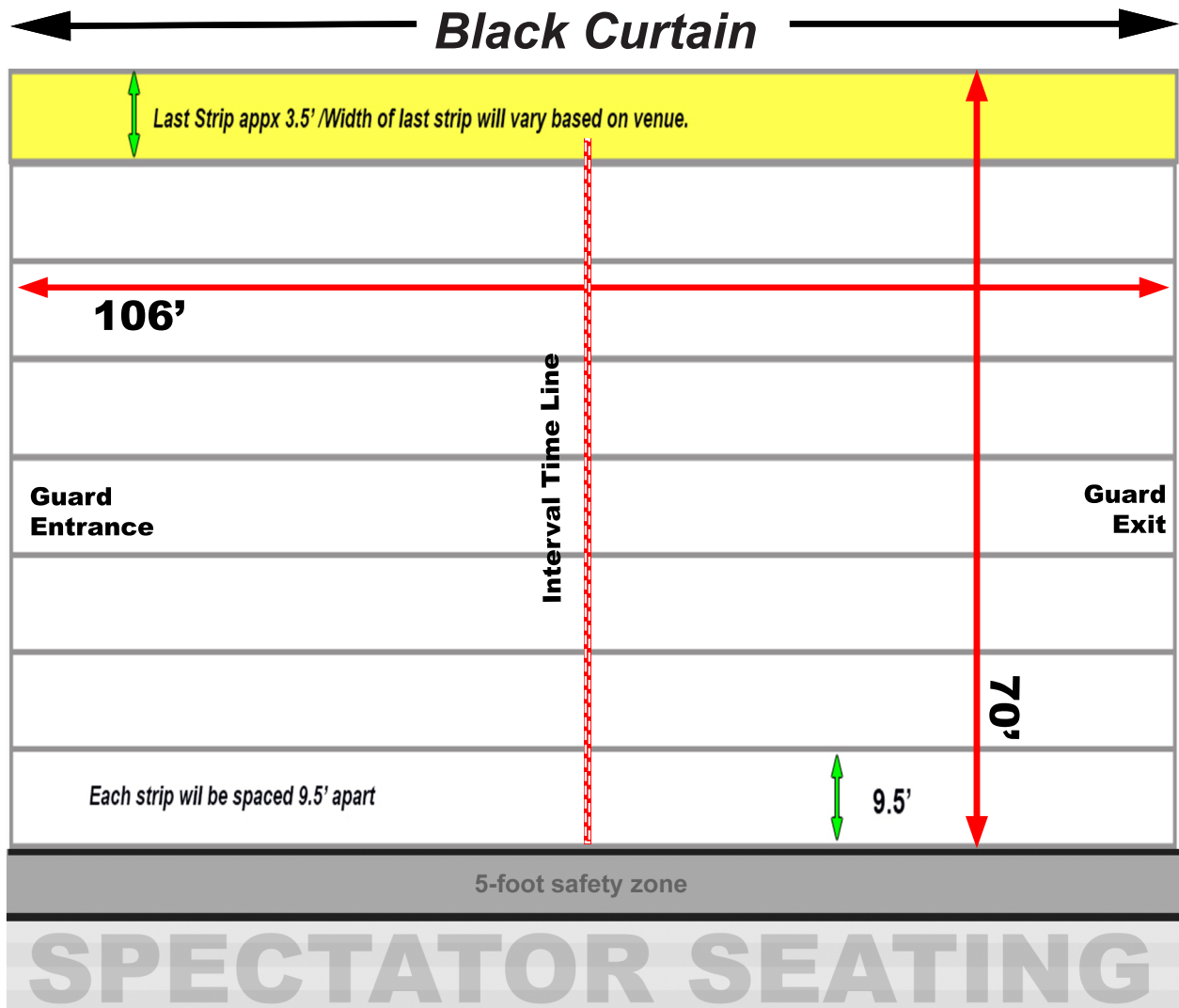

## Color Guard World Championships Competition Area Cintas Center @ Xavier University, Cincinnati, OH

All WGI contest sites must have a minimum of seventy by one hundred feet (70' x 100') to accommodate a "safety zone" of five (5) feet from any spectator seating. If no spectators are seated on the left and right sides, then the safety zone will be eliminated on the left and right sides of the competition area and could extend to a maximum of 78' X 106'.

The "competition area" at this event measures 70' X 106'. All performing groups must be prepared to perform within that area. Floors (tarps) may not extend into the safety zones per rules found in the WGI Adjudication Manual and Rulebook





## **CINTAS ARENA HOUSE RULES**

The following house rules apply to all events held in the Cintas Center:

- All guests will pass through metal detectors upon arriving at the facility.
- Inside the facility, guests agree to abide by the lawful directions given to them by authorized Cintas Center representatives.
- No smoking is permitted inside the facility or on the campus grounds.
- Guests may not bring any food or beverage into the facility nor take alcoholic beverages from the Cintas Center.
- Bottles and cans are not permitted to be brought into the Cintas Center.
- All bags are subject to search.
- Large bags and backpacks are not permitted to be brought into the Cintas Center.
- No firearms or weapons of any kind are permitted inside the facility.
- Guests may not bring laser pens, air horns or any other type of amplification device or pyrotechnic device into the facility.
- No illegal drugs or other contraband are permitted in the facility.
- Balloons are not permitted to be brought into the facility.
- The Cintas Center welcomes assistance animals. No other animals are permitted inside the Cintas Center.
