



## Color Guard World Championships Northern Kentucky University Truist Arena Site Info 500 Louie B. Nunn Drive Highland Heights, KY 41099

- The arena is situated on two floors:
  - $\circ$  The arena level consists of director check in, loading/unloading areas, prop storage, body & equipment warm ups and the performance area.
  - The concourse level consists of the spectator entrance and group photos. All spectator traffic is on the concourse level.
- Parking at Northern Kentucky University is highly restricted. Please instruct those traveling with you to park only in the designated WGI Spectator Parking area. There is a \$5 per vehicle parking fee, **cash only**.
- Each color guard will be allotted 4 parking passes. Buses and trucks do not need a parking pass and will be permitted parking in the Bus/Truck Lot. Bus/Truck lot will open no earlier than 2 hours before the first performance. See maps for details and traffic flow.
- Truist Arena has implemented security screening procedures. Please instruct everyone traveling with you to allow extra time upon arrival. A list of prohibited items is located in this packet. Absolutely no color guard equipment will be permitted in the spectator entrance.
- Traffic can be very congested in Cincinnati and surrounding areas. Truist Arena is located south of downtown Cincinnati. Please plan accordingly.
- The mixing board for the sound system and the sound person will be located by the front stands. The WGI sound person will have control of the level of sound. See contest info packet for sound check times.
- Dressing facilities are limited. Please come in competitive attire.
- The floor surface is concrete. A black tarp will cover the entire competitive floor. The black strips will be placed approximately 9.5 feet apart from the front to the back of the performance floor. The last strip will vary in width.
- The competition area is 106' x 78'. Please see the floor plan for more details.
- A black drape will adorn the back wall of the arena, covering entrances and exits.
- There will be electrical power available at the front and back sidelines.
- Height of the facility is more than adequate.
- There are no floor folding facilities available.
- Buses and equipment trucks must be moved within 1 hour of the conclusion of the color guard's performance. The Furniture Fair parking lot will be used as bus/truck overflow. There is no shuttle from the Furniture Fair lot. Groups are responsible for their own drivers.
- There are separate areas for body and equipment. There is no music allowed in either body or equipment as sound travels to the performance floor.
- Concessions are cashless at Truist Arena.










# Color Guard World Championships Competition Area Northern Kentucky University, Truist Arena Highland Heights, KY

All WGI contest sites must have a minimum of seventy by one hundred feet (70' x 100') to accommodate a "safety zone" of five (5) feet from any spectator seating. If no spectators are seated on the left and right sides, then the safety zone will be eliminated on the left and right sides of the competition area and could extend to a maximum of 106' X 78'.

The "competition area" at this event measures 106' X 78'. All performing groups must be prepared to perform within that area. Floors (tarps) may not extend into the safety zones per rules found in the WGI Adjudication Manual and Rulebook.




# WGI Color Guard World Championships Truist Arena at Northern Kentucky University Overflow Parking

# **Truist Arena Prohibited Items:**

- Aerosol Cans
- Alcohol, drugs, illegal substances or any paraphernalia associated with drug use
- Animals
- Audio/Video recorders
- Backpacks
- Balloons
- Cans, bottles coolers or other similar containers
- Fireworks
- Flags, signs, banners, with poles
- Hover boards
- Laser pens/pointers
- Noisemakers such as air horns or whistles
- Outside food or drinks
- Tripods, monopods or other professional photography equipment
- Selfie Sticks
- Weapons of any type including, chains, knives, firearms and spiked jewelry
- \*\*Other items deemed unacceptable by event/building management\*\*

## SECURITY SCREENING PROCEDURES – GENERAL PUBLIC

- Please plan to arrive early
- All guests and employees are subject to search upon entry.
- Security will perform visual inspections and bag checks using dowels at all entrance points for the particular event, including the employee entrance and the back of house loading dock entrance.
- Event attendees will be screened at the entrances, looking for above prohibited items
- Bags will be checked
- Patrons have the option of discarding prohibited items at entrance point or taking the items back to their vehicle.
