

Percussion World Championships Northern Kentucky University Truist Arena Site Info 500 Louie B. Nunn Drive Highland Heights, KY 41099

- The arena is situated on two floors:
 - $_{\odot}$ The arena level consists of group check in, loading/unloading areas, and the performance area. $_{\odot}$ Indoor prop storage will ONLY be available in the case of inclement weather and at the direction
 - of the Site Manager / Assistant Site Manager.
 - \circ The concourse level consists of the spectator entrance and group photos.
- Parking at Northern Kentucky University is very strict. Please instruct those traveling with you to park only in the designated WGI Spectator Parking area. There is a \$5 per vehicle parking fee – <u>cash</u> <u>only</u>.
- Each group will be allotted 4 parking passes. Buses and trucks do not need a parking pass and will be permitted parking in the Bus/Truck Lot. See maps for details and traffic flow.
- Truist Arena has implemented security screening. Please instruct everyone traveling with you to allow extra time upon arrival. A list of prohibited items is in this packet.
- Traffic can be very congested in Cincinnati and surrounding areas. Truist Arena is located south of downtown Cincinnati. Please plan accordingly.
- Concessions at Truist Arena are **<u>cashless</u>**.
- Dressing facilities are limited. Please come in competitive attire.
- All warm ups will be conducted in the parking lot. There are two tents outside that may be utilized. Please see the logistical schedule for your group's tent times.
- Groups are not permitted to run power from any building power access in any parking lots. Please plan to use generators should you want power in warm up or loading.
- The performance floor will be concrete. A black tarp will cover the entire competitive floor.
- The competition area is $72' \times 106'$. Please see the floor plan for more details.
- A black drape will adorn the back wall of the arena, covering entrances and exits.
- Power Specifications WGI will provide two 20 amp dedicated circuits on the front and back sidelines.
- Buses must move to the designated Bus parking area (Furniture Fair please see attached map)
 <u>IMMEDIATELY</u> after unload. <u>There will not be a shuttle service between Furniture Fair and</u>
 <u>the arena please plan accordingly.</u> Trucks must depart from the truck Unload/Reload area by
 the time listed on your golden ticket.

Truist Arena Prohibited Items

- Aerosol Cans
- Alcohol, drugs, illegal substances, or any paraphernalia associated with drug use
- Animals
- Audio/Video recorders
- Backpacks
- Bags larger than 12" by 6" by 12"
- Balloons
- Camera cases
- Cameras with removable lenses or flash
- Cans, bottles, coolers, or other similar containers
- Fireworks
- Flags, signs, or banners
- Hover boards
- Laser pens/pointers
- Noisemakers such as air horns or whistles
- Outside food or drinks
- Tripods, monopods, other professional photography equipment or selfie sticks
- Pepper spray/mace
- Weapons of any type, including chains, knives, firearms, and spiked jewelry
- No Smoking or Vaping is permitted at Truist Arena
- **Other items deemed unacceptable by event/building management**

If an item is revealed during a search, patrons may dispose of the item, or they may return the item to their vehicle. Truist Arena does not safeguard any personal belongings or items of any type.

Truist Arena Security Screening Procedures – General Public

- Please plan to arrive early.
- All guests and employees are subject to search upon entry.
- Security will perform visual inspections and bag checks using dowels at all entrance points for the particular event, including the employee entrance and the back of house loading dock entrance.
- Event attendees will be screened at the entrances, looking for above prohibited items.
- Bags will be checked.
- Medical bags exceeding 14" x 14" x 6" will be tagged with a bright colored wristband to indicate bag has been inspected.
- Patrons have the option of discarding prohibited items at entrance point or taking items back to their vehicle.






Percussion World Championshiops Competition Area Northern Kentucky University, Truist Arena Highland Heights, KY


All WGI contest sites must have a minimum of seventy by one hundred feet (70' x 100') to accommodate a "safety zone" of five (5) feet from any spectator seating. If no spectators are seated on the left and right sides, then the safety zone will be eliminated on the left and right sides of the competition area and extend to a maximum of 72' x 106'.

All performing groups must be prepared to perform within the competition area. Floors (tarps) may not extend into the safety zones per rules found in the WGI Adjudication Manual and Rulebook.
