- The arena is situated on two floors:
 - The arena level consists of director check in, loading/unloading areas, prop storage, equipment warm up, the performance area and group photos.
 - The concourse level consists of body warm up and the spectator entrance. All spectator traffic is on the concourse level.
- Nutter Center concessions are **CASHLESS**. Ticket box office accepts Mastercard, Visa, Discover, and cash.
- Parking for color guards and spectators is abundant. There is a \$5 per vehicle parking fee (**cash only**).
- Each color guard will be allotted 4 parking passes. Buses and trucks do not need a parking pass and will be permitted parking in the Bus/Truck Lot. See maps for details and traffic flow.
- Nutter Center has specific security screening procedures. Please instruct everyone traveling with you to allow extra time upon arrival. **Absolutely no color guard equipment will be permitted in the spectator entrance. All spectators are subject to clear bag policy and the list of prohibited items can be found in this packet.**
 - Groups entering for their performance on the floor level will not be required to have a clear bag, but should be prepared for bag checks by arena personnel. Bags should be returned to vehicles after the performance if re-entering to watch other groups perform.
 - Anyone entering through the Spectator Entrance and Performer/Staff Re-Entry will be subject to the clear bag policy. Security screening procedures and prohibited items are in this Contest Information Packet.
- Dressing facilities are limited. Please come in competitive attire.
- The floor surface is concrete. A black tarp will cover the entire competition area. The black strips will be placed approximately 9.5 feet apart from the front to the back of the performance floor. The last strip at the back will vary in width.
- The competition area is 106' x 72'. Please see the floor plan for more details.
- A black drape will adorn the back wall of the arena, covering entrances and exits.
- There will be electrical power available at the front and back sidelines.
- Height of the facility is more than adequate.
- The mixing board for the sound system and the sound person will be located by the front stands. The WGI sound person will have control of the level of sound. See contest info packet for sound check times.
- There are no indoor floor folding facilities available.
- Equipment trucks must be moved within 45 minutes of the conclusion of the color guard's performance. Please adhere to the logistical schedule.
- There are separate areas for body and equipment. There is no music allowed in either body or equipment as sound travels to the performance floor.



WRIGHT STATE UNIVERSITY'S NUTTER CENTER SECURITY PROTOCOLS

METAL DETECTORS: All persons will walk through a metal detector or be screened with a hand-held metal detector, to search for prohibited items any time they enter or re-enter the building. **Please allow extra time** to your arrival to the arena to account for this process.

NO COLOR GUARD EQUIPMENT will be allowed in the main spectator arena entrances. Equipment may only enter the building through the warm/up guard check-in entrance and the designated performance entrance at the top of the tunnel. *(See additional information on where groups can leave equipment and props outside backstage).*

PROHIBITED ITEMS: Including, but not limited to: firearms, weapons of any kind, illegal substances, hazardous materials, outside food and drink, strollers, signs larger than 8.5 x 11, tripods, balloons, animals (with the exception of service animals), camera lenses longer than eight (8) inches, laser pointers, and noisemakers.

To provide a safer environment, Wright State University's clear bag policy limits the size and type of bags that may be brought to all Wright State University Nutter Center events.

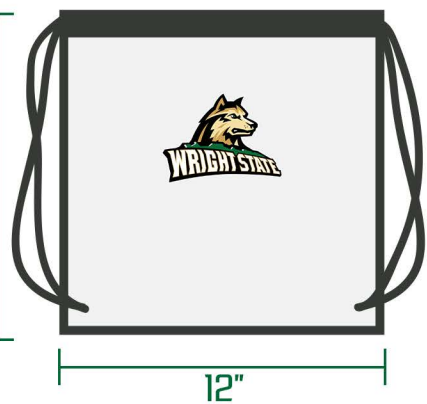
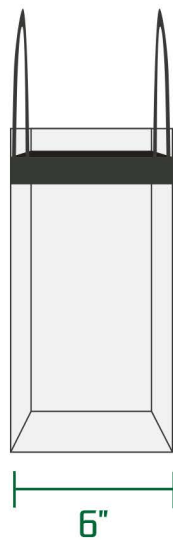
Fans are limited to one bag per person and a small clutch bag for privacy.

No larger than 12" x 6" x 12"



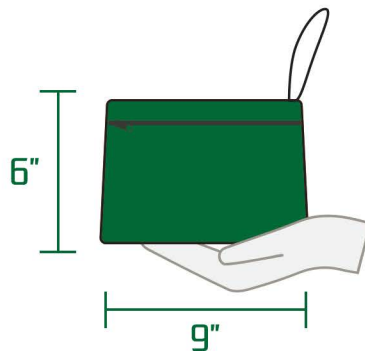
CLEAR DRAWSTRING BAG

No larger than 12" x 12"



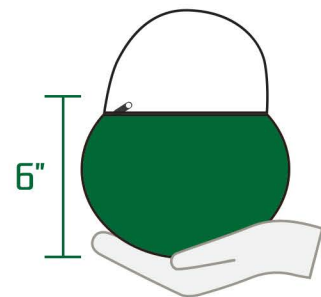
CLEAR STORAGE BAG

No larger than 6" x 9"



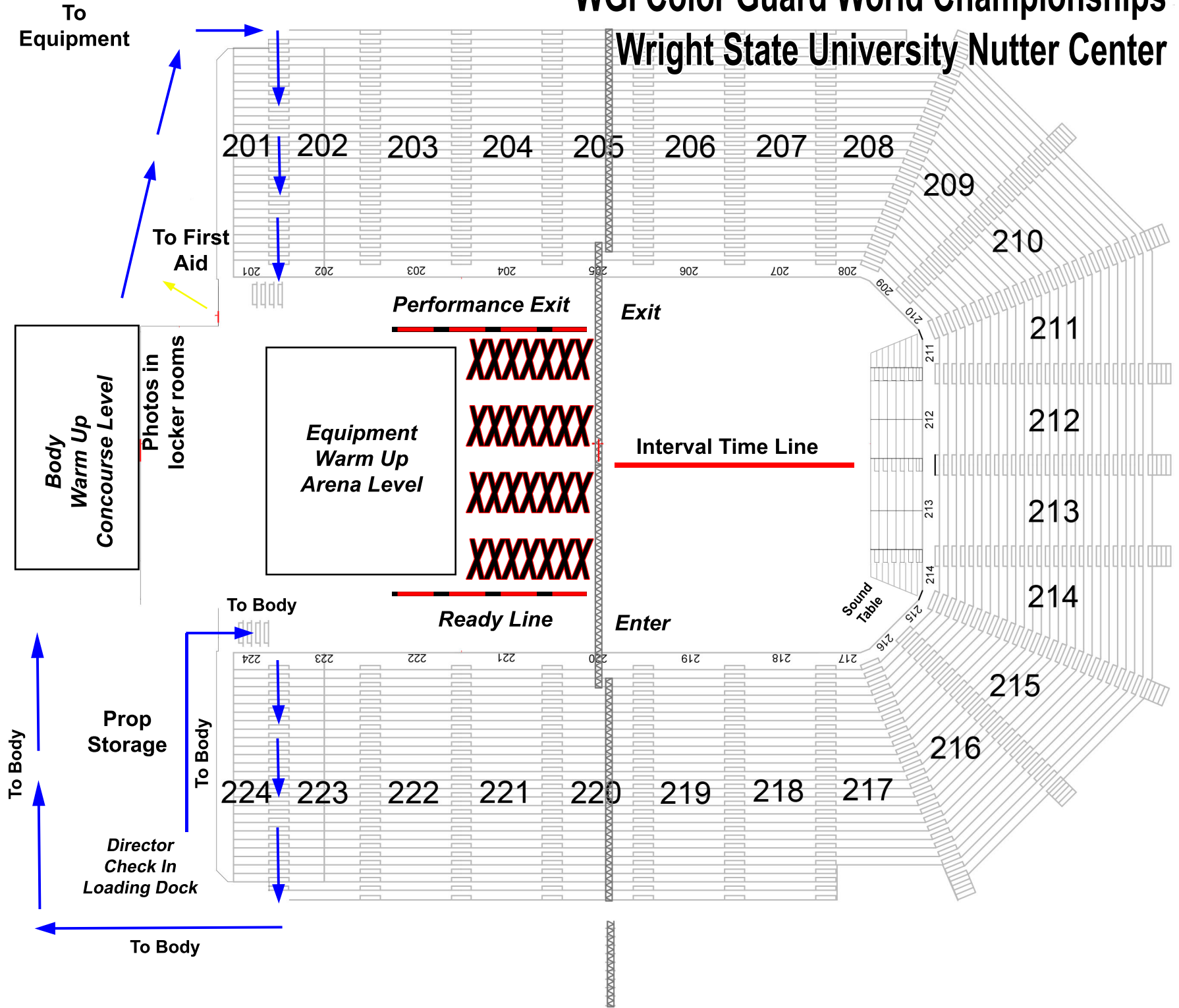

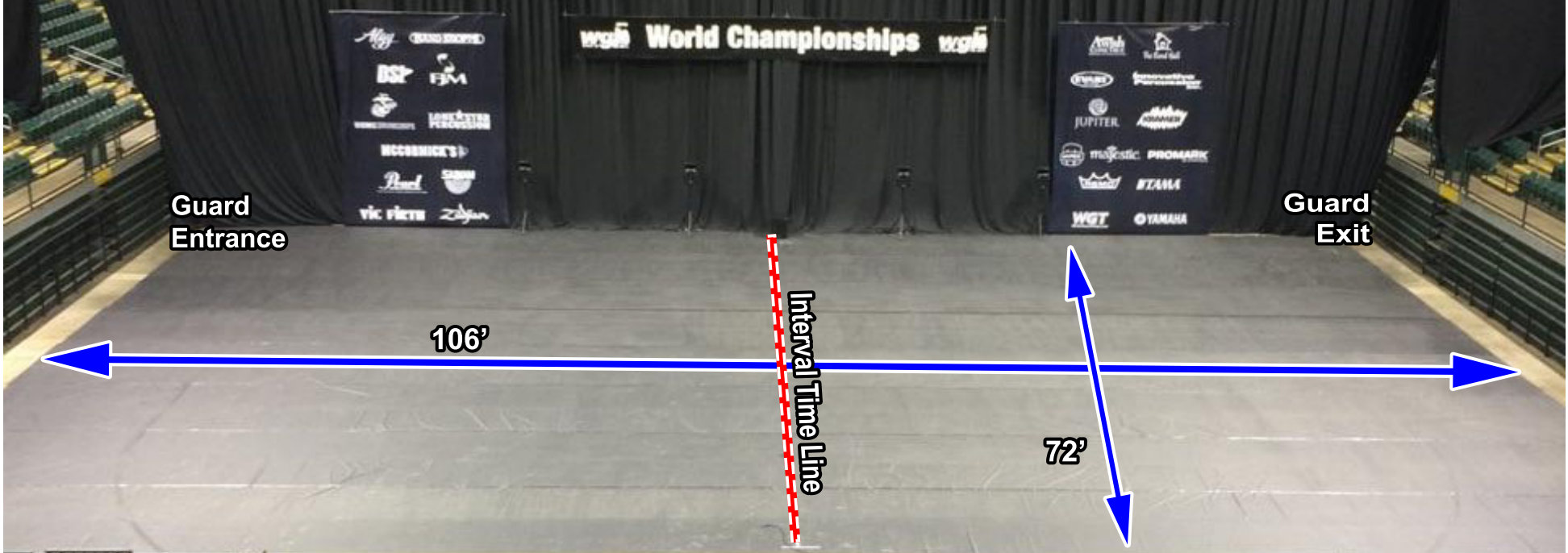

Color Guard World Championships Competition Area Wright State University Nutter Center, Dayton, OH

All WGI contest sites must have a minimum of seventy by one hundred feet (70' x 100') to accommodate a "safety zone" of five (5) feet from any spectator seating. If no spectators are seated on the left and right sides, then the safety zone will be eliminated on the left and right sides of the competition area and could extend to a maximum of 106' X 78'.

The "competition area" at this event measures 106' X 72'. All performing groups must be prepared to perform within that area. Floors (tarps) may not extend into the safety zones per rules found in the WGI Adjudication Manual and Rulebook.
