## General Contest Info

**TO LISTEN TO JUDGES COMMENTARY:** Each director should be set up with an account through CompetitionSuite. This is the **ONLY WAY** to receive judge's commentary for any WGI event. Instructions to do this are available [here](#).

**TARPS:** No unfolded performance tarps allowed in parking lots. As long as space allows without violating any fire codes, you may use a practice tarp and it must be labeled "Practice." Violation of this policy is subject to penalty.

**INSPECTION:** Located in prop unloading (band room).

**WARM-UP AREA:** All maps are in this packet. Ensembles should report one hour prior to performance time.

**PRELIM SCORES:** Posted in the gym lobby area.

**CRITIQUE:** You **MUST** sign up for your critique time upon check in. Please see schedule for critique start time.

**RECAPS AND FINALS INFO:** Pick up 20 minutes after conclusion of your class prelims at the announcer's table.

**FINALS SCHEDULE:** The finals schedule will be made available to you after it has been determined.

**VIDEO TAPING:** No video cameras will be allowed in any contest venue and no authorized space will be provided for groups to record their performance. Any liability associated with unauthorized recordings will rest with the individual or organization making the recording. WGI does not condone, nor accept any liability for, any unauthorized recording during the event.

## Tampa Regional Competition Area Plant City HS, Plant City, FL

All WGI contest sites must have a minimum of seventy by one hundred feet (70' x 100') to accommodate a "safety zone" of five (5) feet from any spectator seating. If no spectators are seated on the left and right sides, then the safety zone will be eliminated on the left and right sides of the competition area and extend to the wall.

The "competition area" at this event measures 106' X 72'. All performing groups must be prepared to perform within that area. Floors (tarps) may not extend into the safety zones per rules found in the WGI Adjudication Manual and Rulebook
