### General Contest Info

**TO LISTEN TO JUDGES COMMENTARY:** Each director should be set up with an account through CompetitionSuite. This is the ONLY WAY to receive judge's commentary for any WGI event. Instructions to do this are available [here](#).

**WARM-UP AREA:** All maps are in this packet. Groups should report one hour prior to performance time. There is to be no music allowed in the warm up area due to the shared warm up space.

**TARPS:** No unfolded performance tarps allowed in parking lots. You may use a practice tarp and it must be labeled "Practice." Violation of this policy is subject to penalty.

**PRELIM SCORES:** Posted in the Foyer

**CRITIQUE:** You MUST sign up for your critique time upon check in and report to the critique room at your classes designated start time.

**RECAPS AND FINALS INFO:** Pick up 1 hour after the conclusion of your class prelims at announcer's table.

**FINALS SCHEDULE:** You will receive a text from competition suite when the schedule is ready.

**FINALS:** All finalists will need to check back in at group check in to go into finals rotation and receive your group check in packet for finals.

**VIDEO TAPING:** No video cameras will be allowed in any contest venue and no authorized space will be provided for groups to record their performance. Any liability associated with unauthorized recordings will rest with the individual or organization making the recording. WGI does not condone, nor accept any liability for, any unauthorized recording during the event.

**PRACTICE SITES:** Groups making practice arrangements through the regional committee must settle their bill at check in upon arrival on Saturday. **Any group with unsettled bills will not be allowed to compete.**

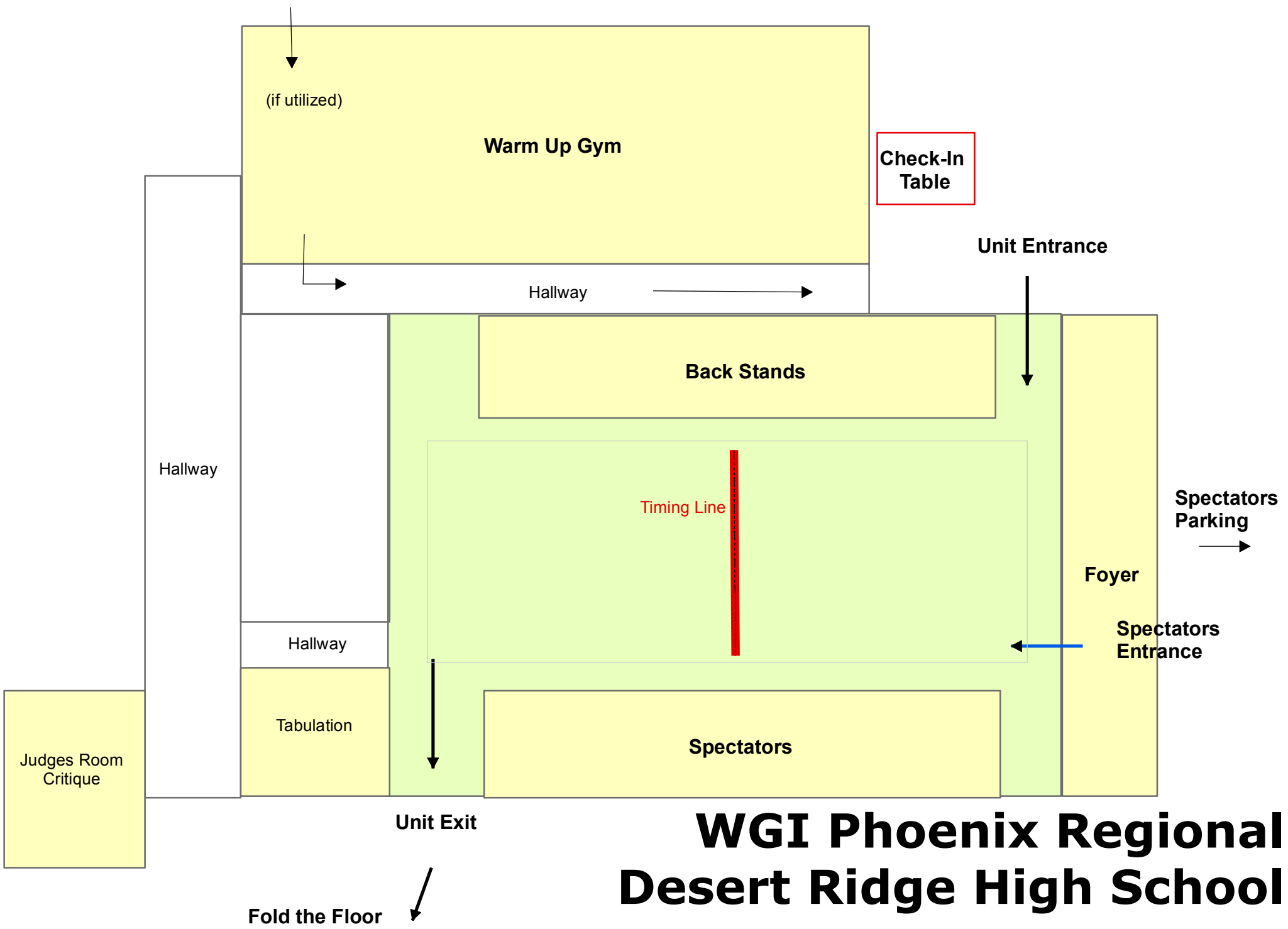

## Phoenix Regional Competition Area Desert Ridge HS, Mesa, AZ

All WGI contest sites must have a minimum of seventy by one hundred feet (70' x 100') to accommodate a "safety zone" of five (5) feet from any spectator seating. If no spectators are seated on the left and right sides, then the safety zone will be eliminated on the left and right sides of the competition area and extend to the wall.

The "competition area" at this event measures 98' x 74'. All performing groups must be prepared to perform within that area. Floors (tarps) may not extend into the safety zones per rules found in the WGI Adjudication Manual and Rulebook
